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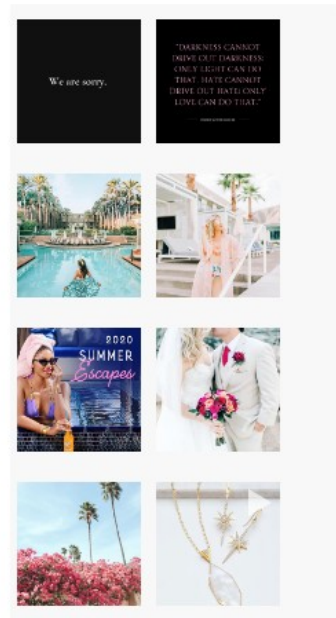

In honor of our new favorite day, we rounded up some of the best places around the Valley to enjoy rosé on June 9 and beyond.

BLUSH International Rose Festival

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What better way to *rosé all day* than at a full festival dedicated to the pink drink? Arizona's inaugural **BLUSH Rosé Festival** will take place on Saturday, June 9 at Old Town Scottsdale venue, [The Clayton House](#) with unlimited tastings from over 75 rosé varieties provided by [Young's Market Company](#), as well as rosé inspired cocktails, rosé and even pink beer. Guests can sip the day away at any one of three different drinking and dining affairs including Brunch + Bubbles from 11a – 2p with brunch faves from [The Montauk](#), the Tapas Experience from 3p – 6p with bites from [Farm & Craft](#) and finally Eat, Drink & Rosé from 7p – 10p. Chapoutier Belleruche Rosé for \$13, and Borsao Rosé for \$13. Because you can never have too many rosé options.

Royal Palms Resort and Spa

If you're more about eating your rosé, then head to T. Cook's at Royal Palms Resort and Spa where they're serving up a special dessert for National Rosé Day. The apple rose tarte tatin is made with house-made rosé milk gelato and can be all yours for just \$10.50. So you can have your rosé and eat it too.
